College Readiness Coaches Compensation:

- Tuition and Fees (last dollar, after grant aid)
- Hourly Rate: \$10 per hour (up to 19.5 hours)
- Mileage Reimbursement over 20 miles

- University meets with High School
- Memorandum of Understanding Initiated
- H.S. Counselor meeting with Director at University to discuss:
- Dates, Times, Roles and Responsibilities



Who are the College Readiness Coaches?

- Current Undergraduate and Graduate Students
- Minimum GPA Criteria: 3.0GPA
- Full Time Student (12 hours or more)

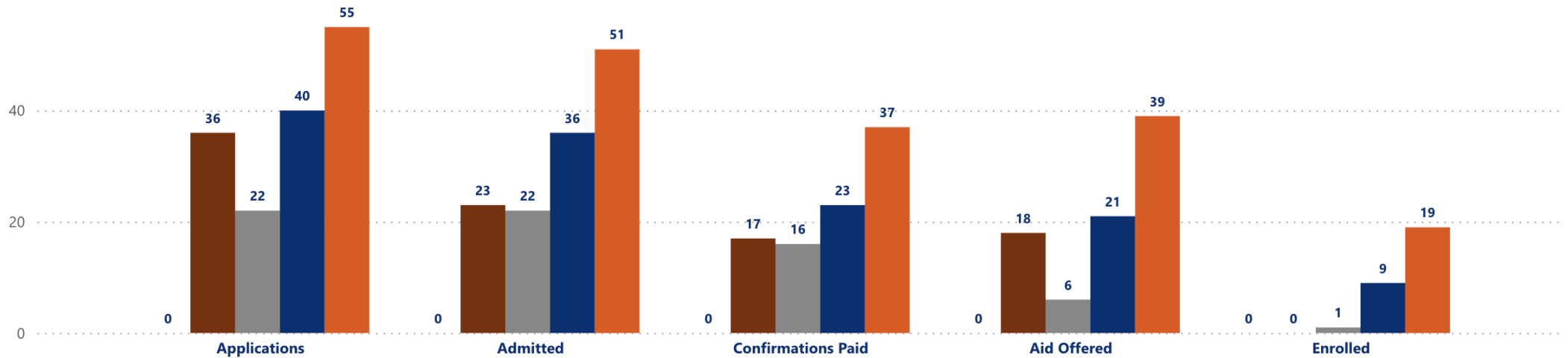

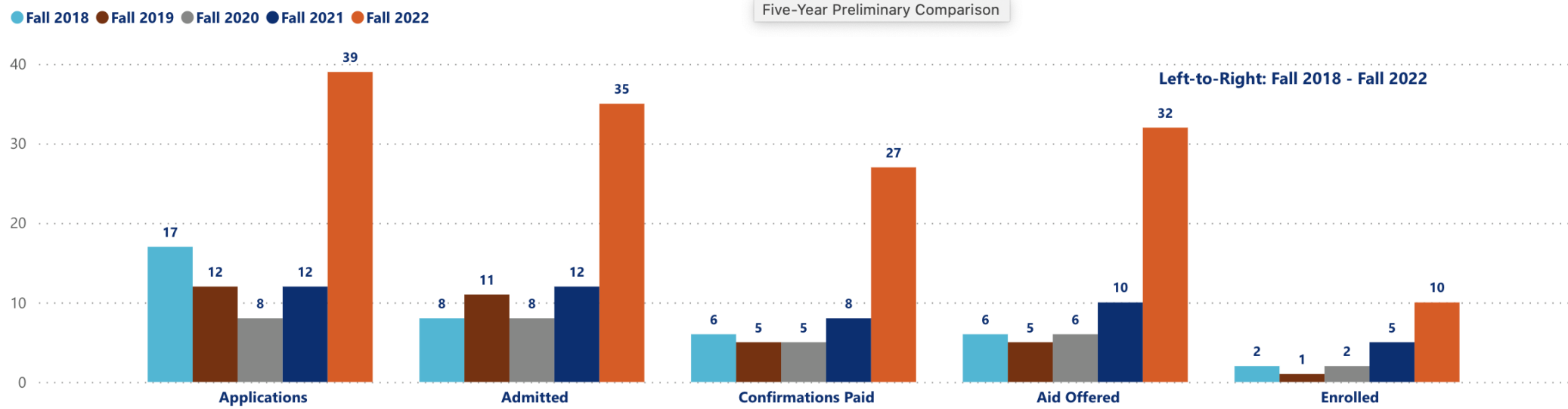
