



TYPES OF PARTNERSHIPS

TUITION ASSISTANCE

TUITION REIMBURSEMENT

Paid as soon as the student starts their course.

Different Coverage Levels

- \$5250
- Fully funded degree programs

Employer may require FAFSA, but may not be necessary.

Paid AFTER successful course completion

• Grade restriction?

Requires students to have a different funding source at the ready.
