Sample Campus-Defined Importance/Satisfaction Items

The RNL Satisfaction-Priorities Surveys (SPS) provide space for campuses to define up to ten items (twenty items on the ASPS) which are specific to the institution. These items must be phrased positively so students can respond with an indication of the level of importance and the level of satisfaction. Following are sample items for your consideration which your campus may use as stated or may use as a starting language to further customize your campus-defined items. Many of these items have been created and used by client institutions for their own survey administrations. They are organized by topic areas to assist you with your review.

Please also be aware that you are welcome to use standard items from other RNL SPS instruments as your campus-defined items. However, corresponding national comparisons will not be provided.

Note, there is a 125-character limit per question (spaces are counted as characters).

Academic

- Most of my classes get me actively involved in learning.
- The core curriculum provides the basic knowledge and skills needed to succeed in college and in later life.
- Coursework is challenging and demands my best effort.
- The academic program offered by the college is sufficiently challenging.
- Faculty members allow me to express my opinions in the classroom.
- Students are encouraged by faculty to think critically and to analyze information given in class.
- My courses are preparing me to communicate effectively.
- My courses are preparing me to work effectively in teams.
- Academic requirements and policies written in the catalog are easily understood.
- Academic requirements and policies are fair and reasonable.
- High quality remedial courses are provided if I need them.
- The attendance policy has helped me to perform at a higher level.

Learning center/tutoring

- Tutors are knowledgeable and helpful.
- The learning center has adequate services for my needs.
- Tutoring is available for students needing it.
- Students are able to find help to improve study skills.
- The amount of tutoring available to students is sufficient.

Academic advising

- My advisor provides me with accurate information about courses, programs, and requirements.
- My academic advisor adequately assists me with career planning issues.
- Academic advisors are usually available after class and during normal office hours.
- My advisor listens attentively.
- My advisor helps me find the resources and information I need.
- After visiting my advisor, I am better prepared to proceed with my college/career goals.
- Advisors are informative and helpful when students decide to change majors or colleges.
- My academic advisor cares about me as an individual.
- My faculty advisor is readily available.
- My academic advisor is knowledgeable about General Education requirements.
- My academic advisor encourages me to use college resources (i.e. career counseling, tutorial services, the health center, etc.)
- My academic advisor assists me in developing long-range plans.
- My academic advisor helps me learn how to make decisions.
- My academic advisor assists me in clarifying my career goals.
- My academic advisor helps me with personal problems or issues.
- My academic advisor is usually available.
- My academic advisor communicates with me effectively.
- There are adequate services to help me decide on a transfer school.

Financial aid services

- Students have a good idea of how much a college education will cost.
- This institution helps me develop a personal budget and spending plan each term.
- This institution helps me find resources to finance my education.
- My obligations for repayment of student loans are explained to me.
- Financial aid counseling is available if I need it.
- This institution provides helpful information on the appropriate use of credit cards.
- Students receive useful information on how to balance school and work.
- Students are notified promptly when student loan funds are available.
- The business and financial aid offices work closely and cooperatively at this institution.

- The financial aid staff is informed and knowledgeable about policies, procedures, and regulations.
- The institution's financial aid policies and procedures are student-centered.
- The institution's letters and brochures about financial aid and scholarships are accurate and informative.
- The financial aid staff is caring and concerned about students.
- The financial aid staff is available and accessible to students.
- The financial aid office actively notifies students of changes in financial aid policy and procedures.
- Financial aid staff or advisors automatically call or meet with returning students after award letters are mailed.
- The financial aid office provides privacy for the discussion of personal and financial matters.
- The financial aid office is easy to find on the campus.
- Admissions counselors are knowledgeable and informed about financial aid and scholarships at this institution.
- The admissions and financial aid offices work closely and cooperatively at this institution.
- The amount of financial assistance available to students is sufficient to make the college affordable to students.
- The financial aid process at this college is clear to me.
- Adequate financial aid assistance is available beyond grants and loans.
