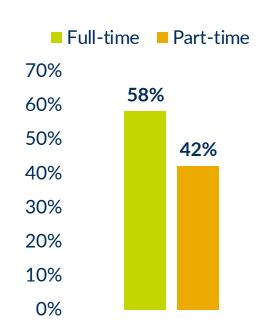

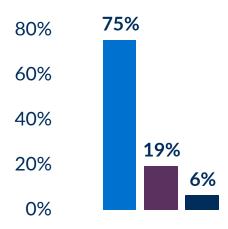

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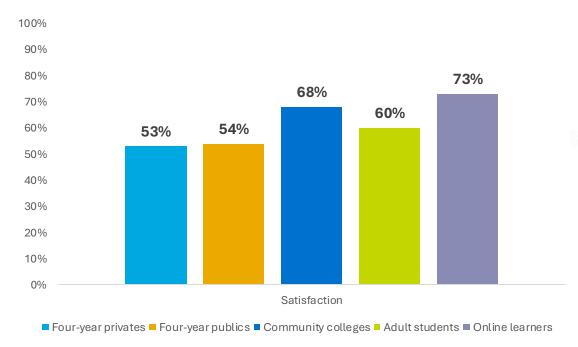

#### How satisfied are college students?

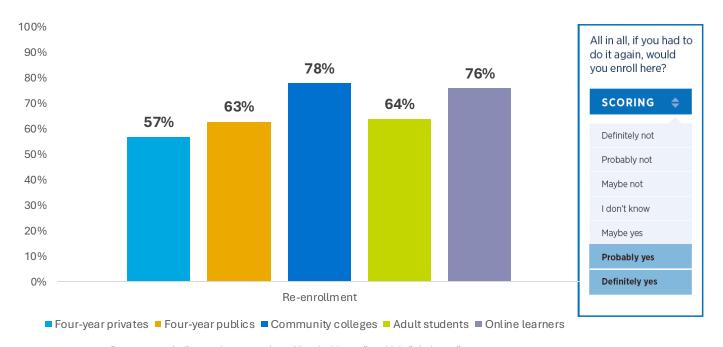

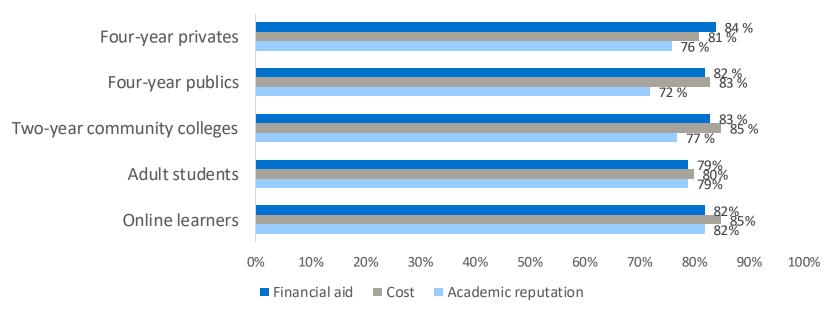
#### How likely are students to re-enroll?



 $Percentages \ indicates \ the \ proportion \ of \ "probably \ yes" \ and \ "definitely \ yes" \ scores$ 



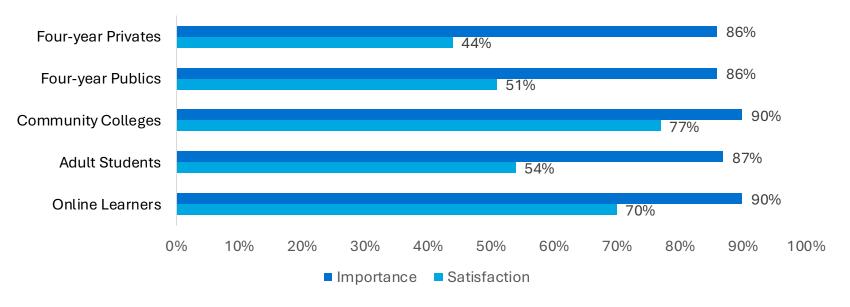
#### **Factors in the decision to enroll**

#### **The Salem Advantage**

Salem College is a private women's liberal arts college in Winston-Salem, North Carolina. Founded in 1772, it is the oldest women's college in the country.

Signed a co-admissions and scholarship agreement earlier this year enabling Forsyth Tech students to transfer with a maximum annual tuition of \$3,000.

Tuition at Salem College is \$32,236 for a commuting student for the 2023-24 school year.

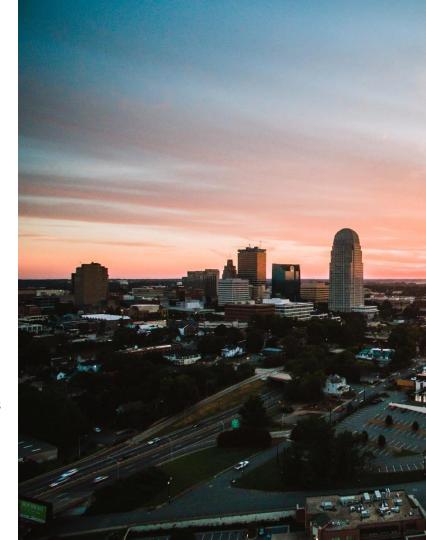

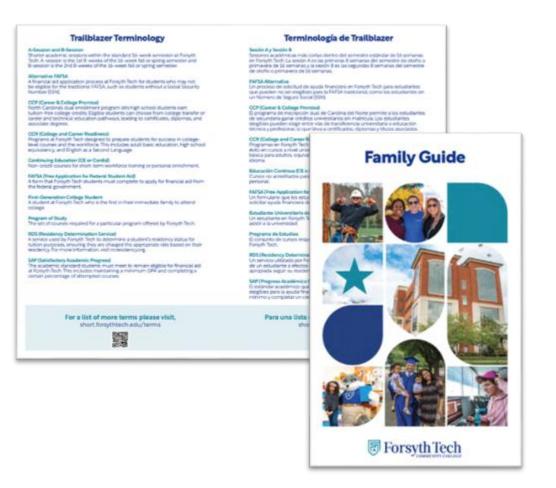


#### **Hispanic Learners**

#### **First Gen**

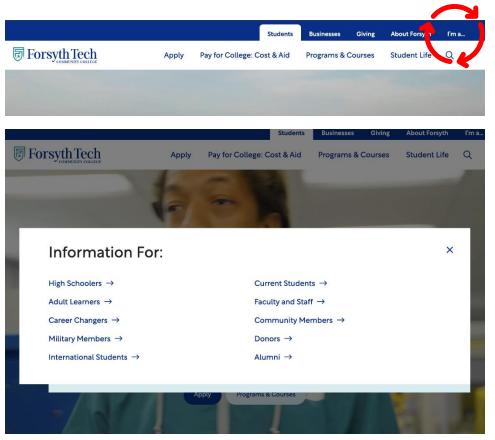
- Community Building: Creating a supportive community through clubs and events, fostering a sense of belonging and support.
