




Enrollment Roundtable






Local Public High School Matriculation













- Mental Health and Wellness




Fall to Spring retention

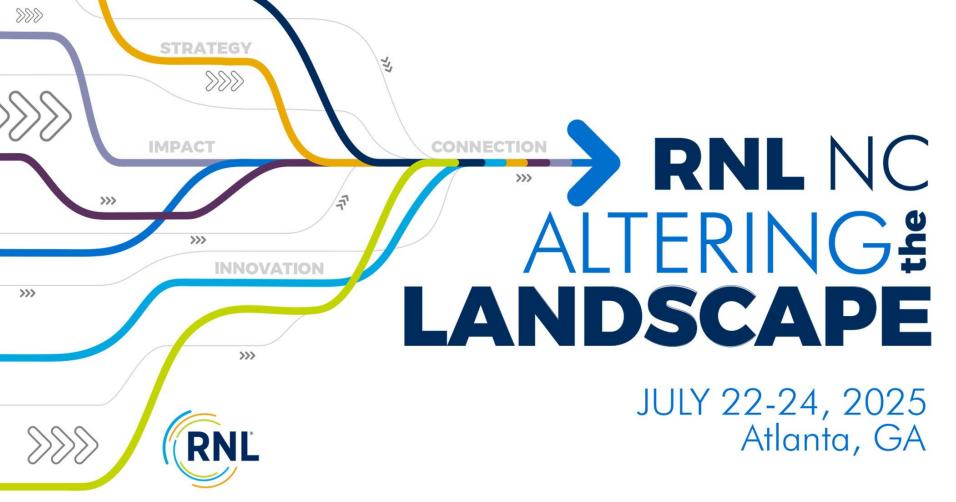
