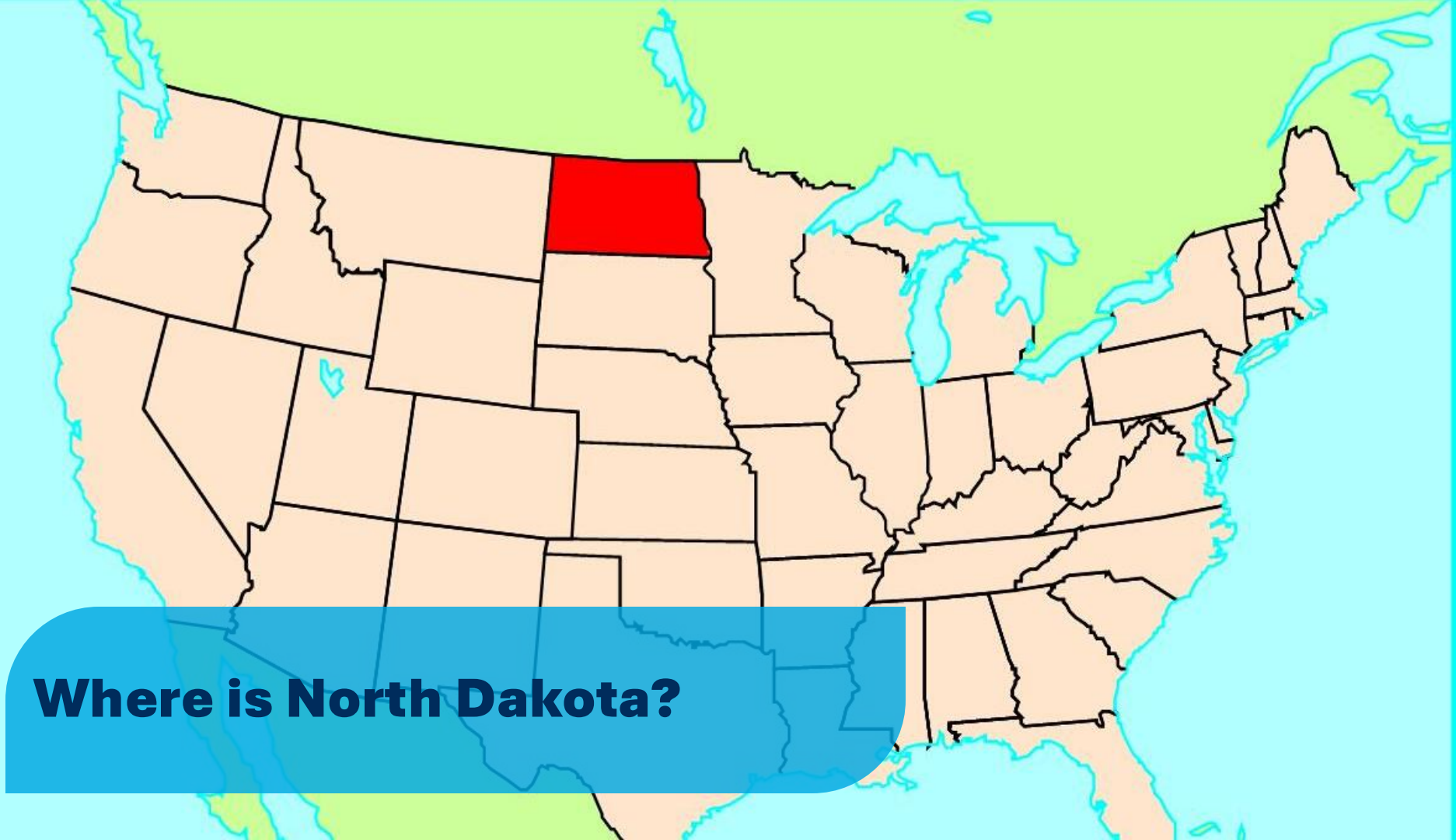

Problem

Manual tracking and analysis of ND legislative session is manpower intensive for NDUS.

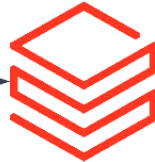

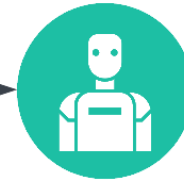

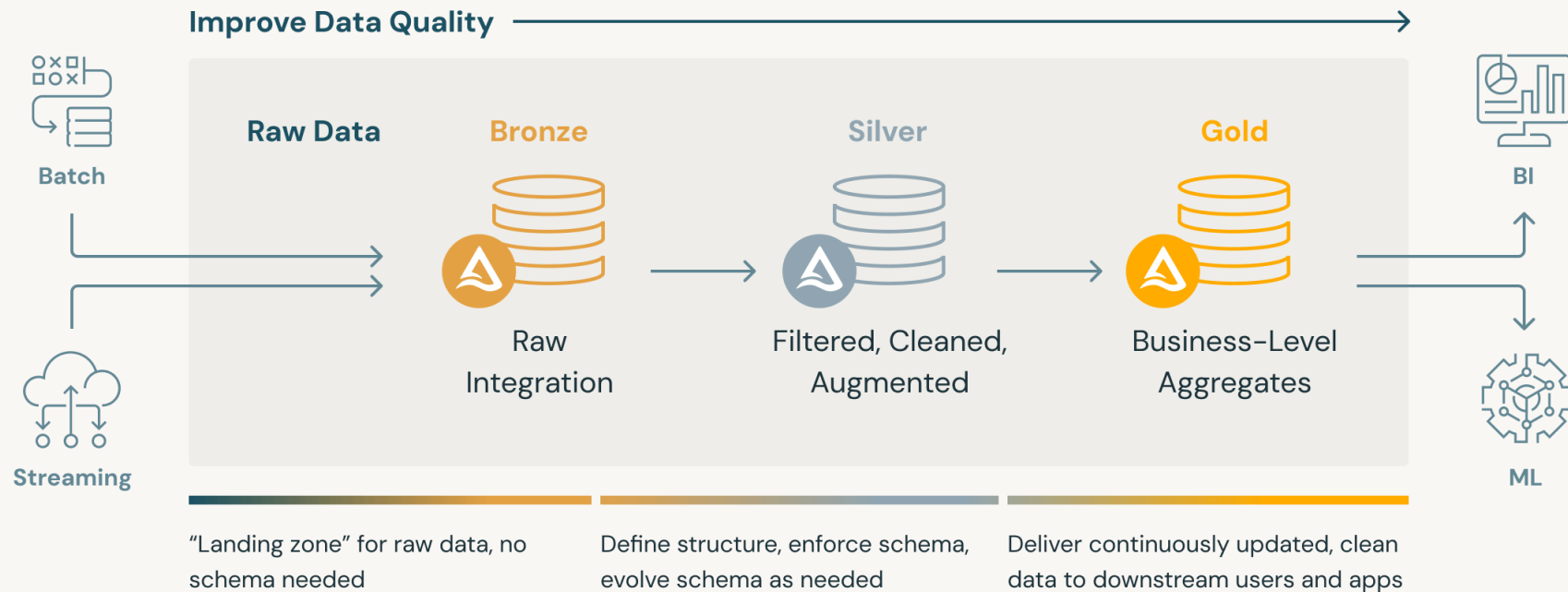

Data Categories

Bills: Details about proposed laws, including their content and status.

Bill Versions: Different drafts or revisions of the proposed laws.

Bill Hearings: Meetings where the proposed laws are discussed.

Bill Actions: Steps taken on the proposed laws, like votes or amendments.

Bill Sponsors: Legislators who support and promote the proposed laws.

Committees: Groups of legislators assigned to review and discuss specific topics or proposed laws.

Committee Members: Legislators who are part of these groups.

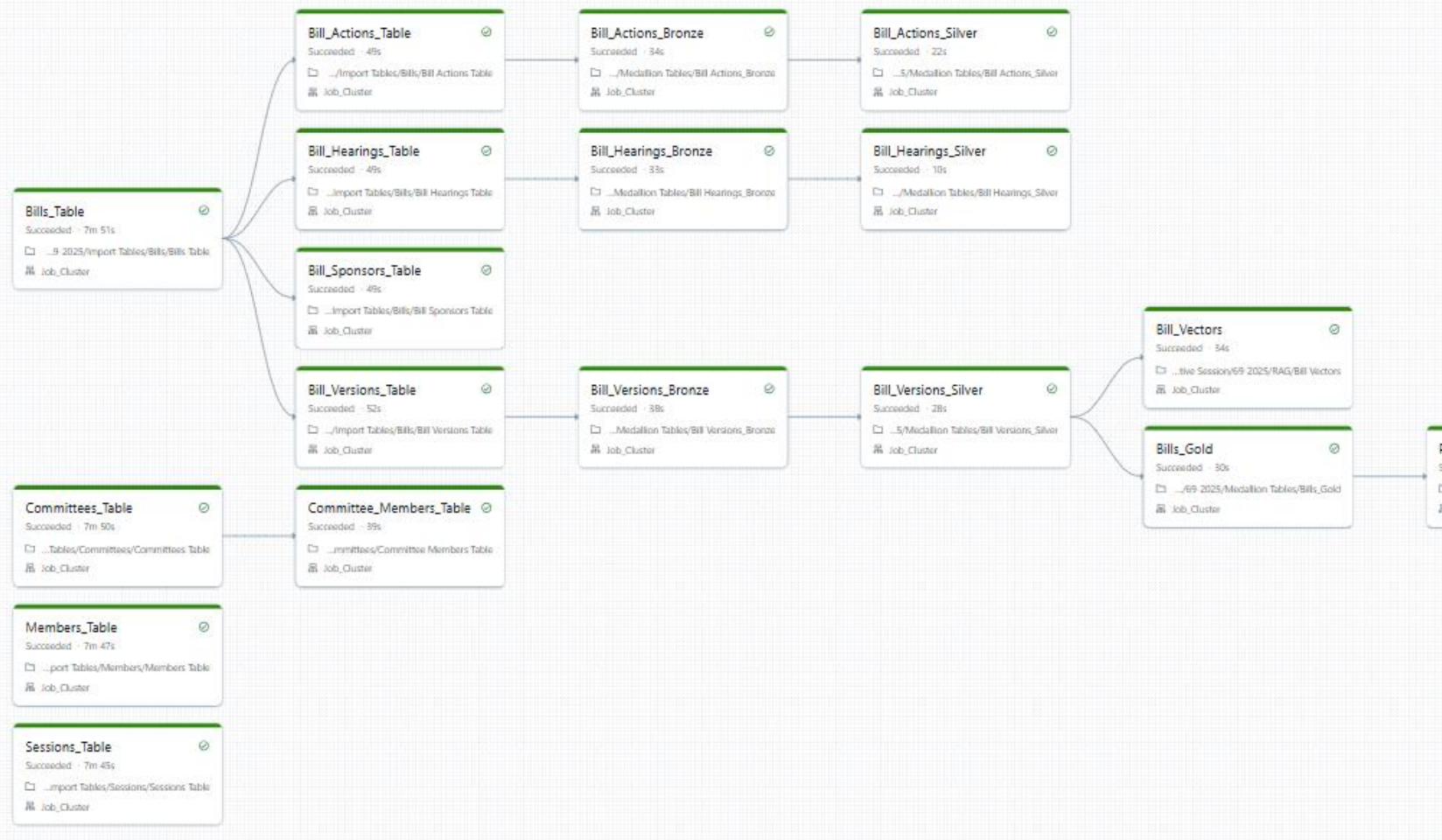
Members: Information about the legislators themselves.

Sessions: Details about the legislative sessions, such as dates and key events.

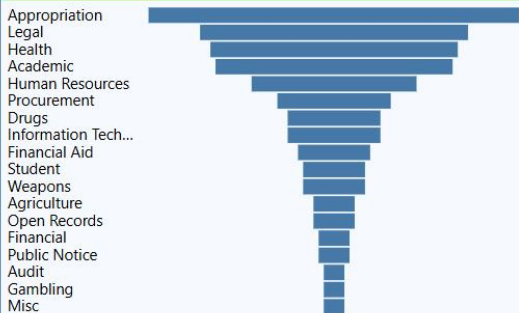

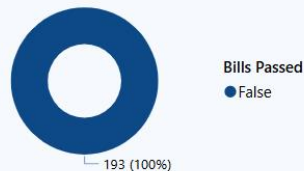

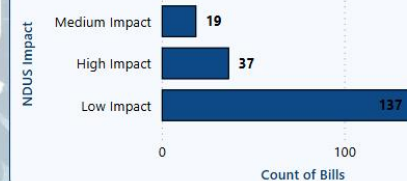
Count

by Bills Passed



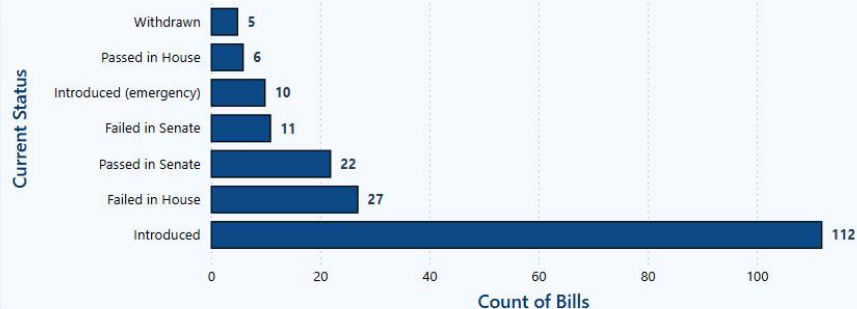
Count of Bills

Summary of the Bill/Amendment: The proposed legislation seeks to create the North Dakota student teacher scholarship program, which endeavors to provide financial assistance to student teachers pursuing initial teacher licensure post-graduation. The bill outlines the responsibilities of the State Board of Higher Education (SBHE) in developing and managing this scholarship program, including distributing funds to institutions with state-approved teacher preparation programs and offering administrative support. Students eligible for this scholarship must be enrolled in a state-approved program and be actively completing their student teaching experience within North Dakota. Each eligible student can receive a scholarship up to \$3,000 applied to their tuition and fees for the semester of their student teaching. An appropriation of \$4,200,000 from the general fund is designated to finance this initiative for the biennium from July 1, 2025, to June 30, 2027.

Impact on NDUS and SBHE: The enactment of this bill would require SBHE to take on new administrative duties, including the establishment and oversight of a scholarship program across multiple higher education institutions within the NDUS. This could enhance the attractiveness of teacher preparation programs, potentially increasing enrollment and helping to address teacher shortages in the state. However, the SBHE may face challenges associated with the efficient management of funds and ensuring compliance across institutions.

Financial Implications: In the short term, the bill provides a significant financial allocation of \$4,200,000 to support the scholarship program, which will require careful budget management and distribution mechanisms. This funding could alleviate financial barriers for student teachers, potentially increasing graduation rates and licensure candidates. Long-term financial sustainability of the program will be crucial, necessitating strategic planning to ensure continued financial support

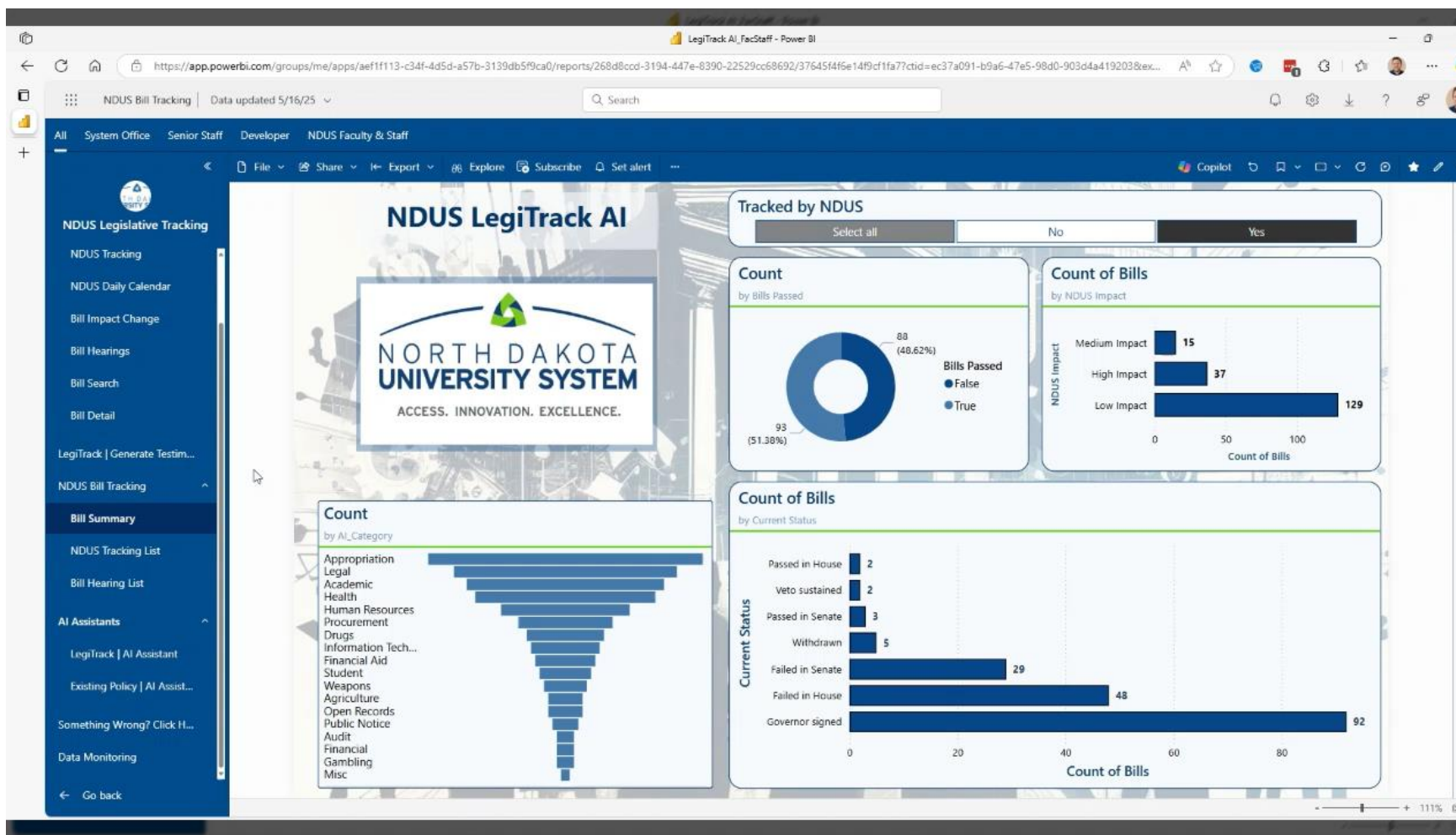
Support for the Bill:
