

# RNL Alumni Success Content - Emsi Standard Terms & Conditions

### I. License Terms and Disclaimers

#### A. License

Licensees of Go Recruit are granted a non-exclusive, nontransferable, non-assignable limited license to access data (the "Licensed Dataset") through the Go Recruit app as follows:

- 1. Unless otherwise stated in a written agreement, login credentials (a username and password) will be issued only to employees of a Licensee ("authorized users"). Login credentials may not be shared. Licensee will not allow access to Emsi Apps by anyone who has not been assigned login credentials by Emsi.
- 2. Licensee and Licensee's authorized users may (i) download infographics using the download tools in Go Recruit for Licensee's internal use, and may (ii) publish static elements (e.g., tables, charts, graphs) of the Licensed Dataset in work products created by Licensee in the normal course of Licensee's business, either for Licensee or for a third party, provided that Emsi is cited as the source of the data. The citation shall be substantially in the form described as "Powered by Emsi" or "Data provided by Emsi (www.economicmodeling.com)"
- 3. Licensee may also create its own reports using the individual datapoints within the Licensed Dataset.
- 4. Licensee may not distribute any part of the Licensed Dataset to a third party in any manner that allows it to be further manipulated for that third party's independent use.
- 5. Neither Licensee nor Licensee's authorized users will attempt to replicate Go Recruit or the Licensed Dataset in design, content, or functionality.

### **B.** Disclaimers

- 1. Licensee acknowledges that Go Recruit and all data and information are provided on an "as is", "as available" basis. The data, reports, forecasts and services provided by Emsi are generated using data from many open web, proprietary, and government data sources, which in turn gather and interpret data using a variety of sources and methods. - **Computer hardware:** Go Recruit will run effectively on a computer that is configured with the hardware, internet connection and operating system needed to run one of the modern, updated web browsers listed above.
- **Display:** For the best experience using Go Recruit, we recommend that your monitor is set to a resolution of 1280x1024 pixels or higher.
